### *Candidate Qualifications:*

In accordance with the standard eligibility requirements for a city office, a candidate must:

- be a United States citizen;
- be 18 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled at the election;
- have not been determined mentally incompetent by a final judgment of a court;
- have not been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities;
- have resided continuously in the state for 12 months and in the city for at least six months preceding election day;
- must be a qualified voter in the municipality.

*Additional Information:*

Alderman and Mayor positions serve a two year term. Currently the Board meets twice every month, the first and third Thursdays at 6:00PM.

Applications may be picked up at Salado's Municipal Building between 8:00AM and 4:30PM, Monday thru Friday.
