Mayor McCort called the meeting to order at 6:01pm, quorum present.

The Pledge of Allegiance and the Texas Pledge of Allegiance were recited. Invocation by Carl Thompson of Presbyterian Church of Salado.

Citizen Comments: None.

Alderman Fields made a motion to approve the previous meeting minutes dated March 20, 2014. Motion was seconded by Mayor ProTem Fritch. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor's Report: Update on IH35/Thomas Arnold Bridge, Ordinance Reviews, Annexation.

Village Administrator's Report: Priorities Update Handout provided – Requested schedule joint workshop with P&Z to discuss overlay district. Requested that Board come up with priority list for Code Enforcement and will discuss at next Workshop. Reviewed various anonymous letters being circulated and answered the comments contained in the letters. Alderman McDougal reminded the public that they are more than welcome to attend the Workshops as well as Board of Aldermen meetings. Before next Workshop, the Board is requested to determine the Wastewater service area be determined, as noted in Priorities memo. Conceptual design must also be determined. An open house to allow public to discuss and provide input, tentatively scheduled for April 21.

Alderman Fields - Tree Trimming – Working with SVFD and Code Enforcement. They have identified the majority of problem areas. No letters have been or will be sent out. They will knock on doors and advise homeowners. Commended Maintenance for pothole work.

Alderman McDougal - West Side Overlay - provided information on what the Overlay committee does.

4. Discussion of Annexation Exchange with Belton - Reed covered in priorities update.
5. Presentation of Proposed Salado Veteran's Memorial - presentation by Jim Robison of Salado High School. Mr. Robison was commended by the Mayor and Board for his presentation.
