**Purpose:** Voting System Testing (TEC, Chapters 125, 127, and 129)

The Election Department Staff conducted a **Hardware Diagnostic Test** (TEC § 129.022) and an **Internal Logic and Accuracy (L&A) Test** (TEC, § 129.023) with ballots marked to record a predetermined number of valid votes for each candidate and on each measure. The test also included ballots that had votes cast in excess of the number allowed by law in certain races in order to determine the ability of the automatic tabulating equipment to reject such votes and ballots with other improper votes.

The trusted hashes for each unique device in the voting system are for the most current version of the system and were obtained from the Secretary of State's office prior to the Public Logic and Accuracy Test.
