- A. Richard Paul Thomas announced the upcoming Music Friendly (MF) networking event for February was canceled by the host. MF has tried to notify their mailing list, but the city had access to the mailing list and they can't access it. RPT will consult with the new city admin to get information back. Porch and Planet Fest is scheduled for 4/20/24. Native Plant Society (Linda Thomas) won an award as best. Hoping to establish a BioTourism (plants and art mixed together)
- B. Jill Shipman announced that PALS had a successful Taste of Salado great food, attendance, opened up to Bell County, financially promising numbers not in. They have an Art on Parade event planned for the fall. Looking for funding and hosting 10 artists as opposed to 5 from last year. Hoping to keep art on Main Street. Perhaps add Plein Air to Art on Parade or add to Porch & Planet Fest in 2025.
 - Jill would like to be involved with the BioTourism board.
- C. Cathy Sands reported that the Historical Society is setting a date for the move of the church in the next couple of weeks. They would like a video of the church being moved.
 - Carolyn Britt and Cathy Sands are doing interviews with Salado older residents to establish an oral history Joe Pehowski is doing the interviews.
