CSJ 0909-36-187. Installation of approximately 6000 SY of concrete sidewalk and curb ramps, combined; relocating 13 small road sign assemblies; and approximately 3100 SY of topsoil and sod including vegetative watering.

Bidders must submit a cashier's check, certified check, or acceptable bidder's bond with their proposal as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into a contract for the project with the Owner within fifteen (15) days of Notice of Award of the contract. The security must be payable to the Village of Salado in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid submitted.
