**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CONTRIBUTION RATE OF THE VILLAGE OF SALADO TO THE TEXAS MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND APPLICABILITY; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Salado finds it in the best interest of the Village to amend Ordinance No. 2002.2; now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF SALADO, TEXAS:**


**Section 1.** The Board of Aldermen of the Village of Salado, Texas hereby increase the Village's contribution to the Texas Municipal Retirement System to **150%**.

**Section 2.** The Mayor is hereby directed to notify the Board of Trustees of the System that this Village has elected to increase said contribution.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall become effective the 3rd day of July, 2002. Per the Board of Trustees of the Texas Municipal Retirement System, said increased contribution will not be applicable until January 1, 2003.

In the event any one or more of the provisions, clauses, or words of the Ordinance or the application thereof to any situation or circumstance shall for any reason be held to be invalid, or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect any other provision, clauses, or words of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any other situations or circumstances and it is intended that this Ordinance shall be severable and that it shall be construed and applied as if such invalid or unconstitutional clause, section, provision, or word had not been included therein.
