RESOLUTION No. 00-4
APPROVING BID TO SUPERVISE WORKERS IN
FILLING VILLAGE POTHOLE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Salado has acquired the materials necessary to repair on a regular basis potholes and similar defects in roads and streets in the Village of Salado for which the Village has the responsibility; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Village to utilize temporary and work release workers to perform labor in repairing Village Streets and Roads as set forth above; and

WHEREAS, the Village has sought bids for a supervisory person or persons to supervise and oversee such work;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Salado that:

The bid of Horace Kelley, an individual of Salado, Texas to provide supervisory services at a rate of \$20 per hour to consist of one person, with the responsibility to oversee and supervise temporary and work release personnel engaged by the Village from time to time to fill potholes and repair similar defects in city streets is hereby accepted. Mr. Kelley will provide a vehicle necessary for such work at no additional charge, and the Village will provide such tools as are required.

The Village will pay Mr. Kelley, as an independent contractor, and not as an employee, for such services on a regular basis upon the submission of detailed invoices to the Village for such services.
