A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF SALADO BOARD OF ALDERMEN
REGARDING BELL COUNTY PROPOSED 2% HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX
INCREASE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Salado Lodging Properties seek the active assistance of the Board of Aldermen in supporting the rejection of the Expanded Bell County Expo Center Proposed 2% Hotel Occupancy Tax Increase; and

WHEREAS, the local and state hotel tax is currently at 13% in most surrounding cities; and

WHEREAS, the Salado Lodging Properties do not feel that an additional 2% tax to be used at the Bell County Expo Center would provide a valuable return to the Village and it's visitors; and




The Board of Aldermen hereby oppose the proposed 2% Hotel Occupancy Tax increase to benefit the Bell County Expo Center.
