RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE VILLAGE OF SALADO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE RIFLE RESISTANT BODY ARMOR PROGRAM TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF TEXAS.
