

RESOLUTION NO. R-2022-02

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE VILLAGE OF SALADO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR DASH CAMERAS AND A PATROL VEHICLE FOR THE SALADO POLICE DEPARTMENT TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF TEXAS.

WHEREAS, The Board of Aldermen (the "Board") of the Village of Salado, Texas, finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Salado that the Village of Salado seek grant funding from the Office of the Governor for the acquisition of mobile data terminal tablets, body cameras and dash cameras for the Salado Police Department in 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Board agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Office of the Governor grant application; and


WHEREAS, the Board agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Salado assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, the Board designates the Mayor Michael Coggin as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Salado approves submission of the grant application for the acquisition of mobile data terminal tablets, body cameras and dash cameras to the Office of the Governor of the State of Texas.
