

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-24

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE VILLAGE OF SALADO, TEXAS REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2020-16 PROVIDING FOR THE ADDITION OF STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF HESTER WAY AND WINNERS CIRCLE, CREATING A THREE-WAY STOP; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51.032, the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Salado ("Board of Aldermen") is authorized by law to adopt an ordinance, not inconsistent with state law, that it considers proper for the government of the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Transportation Code Chapter 311, the Board of Aldermen has broad discretion and authority over municipal streets; and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2020, the Board of Aldermen adopted Ordinance Number 2020-16, providing for the addition of stop signs at the intersection of Hester Way and Winners Circle, creating a three-way stop; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen has reviewed data regarding the traffic safety and vehicular flow and now finds it reasonable and necessary to repeal the regulations enacted under Ordinance Number 2020-16.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE VILLAGE OF SALADO, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: The facts and recitations contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found and declared to be true and correct, and are incorporated by reference herein and expressly made a part hereof, as if copied verbatim.

SECTION 2: Ordinance Number 2020-16 adopted on August 6, 2020, is hereby repealed in its entirety, and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of conflict with this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions, or application thereof, of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION 4: All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in force, and sections of Ordinances which are inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions contained with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication in accordance with state law.

SECTION 6: It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance was passed was open to the public as required and the public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code
