Mayor Ashe called the meeting to order at 4:50pm, quorum present.

Mayor Ashe explained the requirements for citizens to be able to petition the Village to be annexed within the Village's city limits or ETJ. Mayor Ashe also explained that Salado cannot annex property on it's own due to its size and type.

Linda Pehoski's petition was the only one before the Board that could be considered due to her property being contiguous to Salado's ETJ. The other two properties could not be considered because they are not contiguous to Salado's ETJ and/or do not touch Linda Pehoski's property.


Mrs. Pehoski stated that she thinks that a small corner of her property might already be in Belton's ETJ. Mrs. Pehoski thinks this because of the way the larger map at Belton City Hall shows their ETJ line drawn. It was recommended to her that she have a survey done to determine if that is true.

*Motion was made by Alderman Cooper to adopt Ordinance No. 2004.09 reflecting the petition from Linda Pehoski to annex all of her property that is contiguous to Salado's ETJ and that is not in Belton's ETJ. Motion was seconded by Alderman Epps, motion carried unanimously.*
