Mayor Stalcup called the meeting to order at 1:30, quorum present.

1. Storm Damage Cleanup

Mayor Stalcup explained that this meeting is to determine what methods the Village may take to assist residents with storm damage removal. Commissioner Brown stated that Judge Burrows has declared a local disaster. The county has opened its landfill on Landfill Road to citizens who need somewhere to dispose of tree debris only through May 24th. No construction materials will be allowed to be dumped. The Village has placed a roll-off dumpster at the Salado Plaza parking lot for construction debris.


Commissioner Brown will attempt to acquire trucks with grapples from the City of Temple to assist in debris cleanup. The Village will ask Davy Tree Trimming for a bid per household to chip debris along side of roadways. One item for consideration is a fee per household expected to be about \$150 per household. A flag system may be used to determine what household to bill for the removal. This is to help offset expenses the city will pay for debris removal. The primary arteries will be handled first, then secondary roadways.


Another emergency meeting may be called for Monday, May 19th to assess the conditions.
