Mayor Stalcup went over Clearwater's plans to install monitors in Salado Creek to help with early notification that the creek is rising.

Celebration Center has not yet provided the Village with a master plan of their property on Royal Street and what they want to do with it.

Bush's Chicken does not yet have a septic approval from Bell County and the issue of their detention pond has not yet been settled.

The Economic Development committee will meet on Tuesday, April 26th at 5PM at Salado Creek Winery.

The Robertson Plantation Foundation is starting back up and intends to take over the management of College Hill.

Explained the reasoning for the ETJ attorney fees that the Board will see on tonight's agenda.

Susan Terry and her committee are working on revisions to the Sign Ordinance to be presented to the Board at the May 5th meeting.

Informed the Board about the TMRS prior service credit ordinance they will see at the Board meeting following this workshop.

Carol Walls is working on soliciting new members for next year's Leadership Salado program.

COPS will not meet in April.

Asked about parking issues with Salado Floors and Walls. Mayor Stalcup stated that two parking spots will be graveled behind Salado Floors and Walls on the Village property.

Would like to see a time table on the wastewater plan.

Danney McCort went over what the county does and does not do for road repairs/resurfacing for cities and why the Village bids it out.

This workshop involved only discussion, no actions were taken.
