Discussion on Proposed Wastewater System

Meeting Minutes

Larry Sands called the information gathering meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Mayor Stalcup explained the process the Village has been working towards for a wastewater system for primarily the downtown area and informed the citizens that the Village would need some kind of participation and financial commitment to the project from the businesses and residents.

Copies of the Kasberg, Patrick & Associates feasibility study for the downtown area and copies of the Orenco presentation were available.

Robert Miller with a Orenco gave a presentation on how the Orenco system works and presented to the crowd a slide show showing the different types of Orenco system that are available to small municipalities. Robert answered questions from the audience and stated that the Village of Salado's average flow of waste is 17,500 gallons per day. Robert stated that with the system that Salado is planning on using does not involve building lift stations, with would cost thousands. The Village of Salado plans on using interceptor tanks that would be placed on individuals properties. Robert stated that it would cost approximately 1.4 million dollars for the collection network and treatment system per information taken from the recent waste water feasibility study that the Village of Salado had done. Merle stated that the Village of Salado will contract out the maintenance upkeep on the system and that it would be at no cost to the citizens.

This meeting involved only discussion, no actions were taken.

Meeting adjourned at 7:00PM.
