**1. REGULAR SESSION**

a. CANVASS RETURNS OF THE VILLAGE OF SALADO SPECIAL AND GENERAL ELECTIONS OF MAY 6, 2017 (VILLAGE SECRETARY)

*Judy King presented the election returns to the Board of Aldermen for review. Mayor Blancett offered public recognition and a thank you to Eldon and LaNora Miller for their faithful service to the elections. Alderman Coachman made a motion to approve the election returns as presented. Alderman Dankert seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously 4-0.*

b. DISCUSS AND CONSIDER APPROVAL OF AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF SALADO, TEXAS, DECLARING THE CANVASS OF THE RESULTS OF THE MAY 6, 2017, SPECIAL ELECTION HELD FOR THE PURPOSE OF DECIDING FOR OR AGAINST A DISANNEXATION PROPOSITION, AND THE MAY 6, 2017 GENERAL ELECTION HELD FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THREE (3) ALDERMEN OF THE VILLAGE OF SALADO BOARD OF ALDERMEN AND ALL MATTERS RELATED TO HOLDING SUCH ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS OF FACT, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALING CONFLICTING PROVISIONS, FINDING PROPER NOTICE AND OPEN MEETING, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (CITY ADMINISTRATOR)

*Don Ferguson presented an Ordinance declaring the canvass of the results of the May 6, 2017 Special & General Election to be valid. Mayor Pro Tempore Brown made a motion to declare the canvass of the results of the May 6, 2017, Special Election held for the purpose of deciding for or against a disannexation proposition, and the May 6, 2017 General Election held for the purpose of electing three (3) aldermen of the Village of Salado Board of Aldermen and all matters related to holding such election; providing of findings of fact, providing for severability, repealing conflicting provisions, finding proper notice and open meeting, and providing an effective date. Alderman Coachman seconded. Motion passed unanimously 4-0.*

c. COMPLETE AND ISSUE CERTIFICATES OF ELECTION TO THE THREE (3) ALDERMEN-ELECT. (MAYOR SKIP BLANCETT)



Mayor Blancett issued Certificates of Election to Alderman Elect Brown and Alderman Elect Jackson. He announced the changing of the guard at the next meeting of the Board of Aldermen to be held on Thursday, May 18, 2017.

Mayor Pro Tempore Brown made a motion to adjourn. Alderman Dankert seconded. Motion passed unanimously with a 4-0 vote.
